The Animal Agriculture Alliance, along with the farmers, ranchers, associations and companies we represent, is disappointed in TGI Friday's recent partnership with The Mondays Campaigns and promotion of "Meatless Mondays." As a global restaurant brand, we recognize your interest in and commitment to providing choices for every customer, but "Meatless Mondays" does just the opposite.

The campaign is not a grassroots effort to celebrate healthy eating, but a well-funded campaign pushing an extreme animal rights and environmental agenda by promoting false claims about animal agriculture. "Meatless Mondays" seeks to eliminate consumer choice - the ability that we each have to determine the right food choices for ourselves and our families.

While customers increasingly demand healthy dining options, "Meatless Mondays" spreads misinformation about the health benefits of meat and poultry. It is important to provide customers with a complete protein source to obtain a hearty, nutritionally balanced meal. Lean meats align with

the Dietary Guidelines for Americans and the new "MyPlate" food guide. Meat, milk and eggs provide all the essential protein building blocks that our bodies need for optimal health and experts agree that a heathy diet consists of fruits and vegetables, whole grains, dairy and moderate amounts of nutrient-dense meat and poultry.

Vegetarian diets require a lot of vigilance to be healthy, and the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics states that those who lack U.S. Population Replace Incadescent with Energy Star bulbs – 1.2%

meat in their diet completely are at risk for iron, vitamin B12, calcium, vitamin D, zinc and omega-3 fatty acid deficiencies.

The "Meatless Mondays" campaign claims about the environmental impact of meat production are similarly misleading. Today U.S. farmers and ranchers produce more meat and poultry than ever before using less water, less land, less feed and generating fewer greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Environmental Protection Agency data show that all of agriculture contributes just nine percent of U.S. GHGs with animal agriculture contributing less than five percent.







TGI Friday's is a great family restaurant where Americans of all backgrounds and nutrition interests can go to enjoy a fun, delicious meal with a wide range of choices whether they include meat or not. Those choices are one of the elements that make TGI Friday's such a popular restaurant, and we believe teaming with "Meatless Mondays" is counterproductive to your mission of providing the best food and guest experience possible.
